## Second Lockdown Had Successes, Failures

What to know: On Monday, January 29, MSMHS entered an unplanned, full-school lockdown, the second this month. According to MSMHS principal Ms. Amatrudo, the lockdown was triggered by a "vague report" that was deemed untrue after being "investigated fully" through police interviews and review of video footage.

What went well: Principal Ms. Amatrudo emphasized the successful aspects of the lockdown, explaining that

"officers were very happy with how all the rooms were locked down" and that she felt that it was a "successful completion of our emergency procedures."

What didn't go well: Ms. Amatrudo said that there was an incident of student behavior in one location that was "absolutely abhorrent," adding that it "could have jeopardized the safety of other people in that space."




